If you require a bursary and are awarded one, you will receive confirmation of your bursary on 28 October 2024. Please book your visa appointments as soon after this date as possible.

All international family members must obtain the relevant visa in order to live on campus at GWC.

- Proof of funds
- Photographs
- Proof of medical aid membership (we can help with this after you've been accepted)
- South African police clearance if you have been living in South Africa
- Payment for your visa application
